Dr Eric Tan graduated from dentistry from the University of Adelaide and shortly thereafter completed a Masters degree in Prosthodontics from the University of Melbourne. Eric is actively involved in continuing education, and has lectured throughout Australia and internationally on topics relating to implant dentistry, aesthetics, adhesion, occlusion and ceramics, and has published articles relating to these topics. He is involved in the clinical teaching of fixed prosthodontics at the University of Melbourne Dental School and maintains a Private Specialist Prosthodontic Practice in Toorak, Victoria, with an emphasis on aesthetics and inter-disciplinary case management.

Workshop Program

Aesthetic treatment outcomes have become an increasingly important factor in overall case success. This is largely due to an increasing awareness amongst patients about dental aesthetics. Dental aesthetics and smile design can be broken down and discussed as 2 factors - form and colour.

This program will cover the basics of aesthetic smile design and the science of colour and its application to shade selection and material selection in clinical dentistry.

Modern direct composite restorative materials will be discussed, as well as the benefits of adopting a multi-shade system to achieve more consistent aesthetic results. Clear criteria will be presented as to when a single shade restoration is sufficient and when a more complex multi-shade build-up is indicated.

Clinically relevant information will be presented pertaining to preparation design, application of layers and occlusal considerations. Techniques to simplify multiple single-shade restorations will also be discussed.

A two hour didactic lecture will be followed by a hands-on workshop.

Workshop Objectives

- Learning the science of colour.
- Techniques for shade selection.
- Understanding smile design.
- Recognising when you need to use 1, 2 or more shades of composite to achieve acceptable aesthetics depending upon the clinical situation.
- Principles of preparation design in anterior Class IV restorations.
- Learning multi-layering techniques for direct restorations.
- Learning techniques to generate predictable interproximal contacts between restorations and to allow ease of separation.
- Discuss nanocomposite technology.

He has completed studies at the Las Vegas Institute of Advanced Dental Studies in 1999, receiving hands-on instruction from Dr. William Dickerson and Dr. Ronald Jackson. In 2000, he attended the Fahl School of Art and Science in Aesthetic Dentistry (Curitiba, Brazil) and received personal tuition from Dr. Newton Fahl.

Workshop Program

You will learn how to artistically apply composite resin to mimic tooth morphology. You will be taught how to manage almost every case of poor Dental Aesthetics with direct composite bonding, understanding how composite resin can be a beautiful alternative to ceramic veneers, while being conservative and brilliantly aesthetic.

You will be able to return to your clinics and immediately put into practice with confidence the skills acquired from the workshop. You will learn how to treatment plan a wide range of cases of poor dental aesthetics and provide a solution in a single appointment. Your patients will appreciate that you can offer a broader range of treatment options to enhance poorly aesthetic teeth.
